- D. Number of persons to be employed or made self-sufficient by program exit.

The HMIS and CoC Program Planning grants are not scored—as they represent unique categories of Continuum services that do not involve housing or are exempt from scoring, respectively. As stipulated in the Ranking & Scoring Policy of the NY-501 Regional CoC, priority groups in ranking order are Permanent Housing, HMIS, TH/RRH, and New Bonus Projects.
